Lagers

Budvar Budejovicky Pilsner, CZE, 330ml, 5.0% \$8.50
This is the pilsner all others try to emulate. Crisp, floral and easy drinking.

Weltenburger Pilsner, GER, 330ml, 4.9% \$8.50
From the oldest monastery brewery in the world. These monks have few pleasures so make sure they get this beautiful, zesty, refreshing pilsner just right!

Kolsch/Golden Ales

Sunner Kolsch, GER, 500ml, 5.0% \$12
This is the oldest Kolsch in the world for a reason. Spicy and aromatic, doesn't get much better.

Wheat beers

Weihenstephaner Hefeweizen Weissbier, GER, 500ml, 5.4% \$12
From the oldest brewery in the world comes this banana and clove dominated wheat beer. Absolute classic.

Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier Dunkel, GER, 500ml, 5.3% \$12
Same as above, a classic dark wheat beer. Caramel and banana dominates this very easy drinking beer.

Saisons

Brasserie Du Pont, BEL, 330ml, 6.5% \$13
A classic Saison that all others should be compared to. Aromatic with a tart, dry finish that quenches any thirsty tastebuds.

India Pale Ales

Founders Centennial IPA, USA, 355ml, 7.2% \$10
This ales sweet, malty undertones balance the hop character with a finish that never turns too bitter. This is a truly fantastic IPA.

Sierra Nevada Torpedo, USA, 355ml, 7.2% \$10
Solid bitterness and a massive hop flavour but still easy drinking with a pleasant dry finish.

Pale Ales/ Amber Ales/Bitters

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale, USA, 355ml, 5.6% \$9

Found in every corner shop in the US, this is a fantastic, hoppy pale ale with your typical American citrus and pine kick.

Timothy Taylor Landlord Pale Ale, UK, 500ml, 4.1% \$12

Classic English pale ale using only the finest golden promise malted barley and best possible leaf hops. One to keep all you ex pats happy!

St Peters Gluten Free English Ale, UK, 500ml, 4.2% \$12

Sweet, crisp and pretty damn good for a gluten free beer!

Belgium beers

Delirium Tremens Golden Strong Ale, BEL, 330ml, 8.5% \$12

This unique taste results from the use of 3 different kinds of yeast. Not only does this come in a cool, ceramic bottle but is delicious. If you don't believe us, just ask the guys from Forsyth's!

Chimay Blue Strong Ale, BEL, 330ml, 9% \$12

Strong and rich yet easy drinking. Dried fruits and honey make this one truly relaxing beer to drink. Another classic!

Red Ales/Brown Ales/Dark Ales/Scotch Ales

Rogue Hazelnut Amber Nectar, USA, 355ml, 6.2% \$11

Another favourite of ours from the guys at Rogue, this is really good! Beautifully balanced, easy drinking brown ale with the hazelnut essence really coming through as it warms up. Omg!

Theakstons Old Perculiar, UK, 500ml, 5.6% \$12

For the ex pats, this classic Old Ale needs no introduction. Burnt caramel, chocolate and dark fruits dominate with a rich, creamy finish.

Stouts/Porters

Founders Porter, USA, 330ml, 6.5% \$10

I admit we do get very excited about a lot of these beers here at Flat Rock but there is a good reason for that. They are awesome and here is another. Rich, malty and chocolaty, this, in our opinion is the best plain porter out there. Fact!

Founders Breakfast Stout, USA, 330ml, 8.3% \$12

Rated one of the best beers in the world, this double chocolate, coffee, oatmeal Imperial Stout is so good you may never eat breakfast again. Replacing your cornflakes with one of these will actually enhance your life, increase productivity and make you a happier camper!

Rogue Chocolate Stout, USA, 650ml, 6.3% \$22

This is soooooooo good. Seriously, you really have to have this!

Sour Ales

Lindemans Kriek, BEL, 375ml, 3.5% \$13

Another classic from Belgium you really have to try at least once. Being a lambic this is a sour beer but the sweetness from the cherry certainly makes it appeal to the ladies.

Fruit Beers/ Weird Stuff

Founders Rubaeus, USA, 355ml, 5.7% \$12

This brew achieves its unique raspberry taste by the addition of only fresh raspberries at 5 separate stages of the brewing process which along with the flavour, also gives it a pink colour and lovely sweet tartness.

Mid Strength/ Non-alcoholic beer

Budvar Budejovicky Non Alcoholic Pilsner, CZE, 330ml \$8.50

Murrays Punch and Judy, AUS, 330ml, 3.9 % \$8.50
