2012 Little White <i>Willbriggie, New South Wales</i> <i>A refreshingly light Sauvignon Blanc with passionfruit and tropical fruit aromas, melon and grapefruit flavours and just a light touch of fresh-cut grassiness. The crisp acidity adds to very food-friendly, dry finish.</i>	7	21	30
2014 Domaine De La Majone Picpoul De Pinet <i>Languedoc, France</i> <i>A little known French varietal that pairs perfectly with seafood and sunshine. Clean and crisp, with honeysuckle and pineapple overtones leading to burnt sugar and finishing dry with notes of baked fruit.</i>	9	28	40
2015 Heart Wines Pinot Gris +3 <i>Alpine Region, Victoria</i> <i>Young and fresh, this blend exemplifies the new wave of Victorian wine making. Handpicked and basket pressed, a big bouquet opens to buttery pear and melon flavours with a crisp, long finish.</i>	9	28	40

2012 Little Red <i>Bendigo, Victoria</i> <i>An easy drinking Merlot from Bendigo. Medium bodied with notes of cedar, smoke and spice taken from its time on oak. Light tannins and blackberries round out a light finish.</i>	7	21	30
2014 Chateau Thivin 'Manoir Du Pavé' Beaujolais <i>Beaujolais, France</i> <i>Light and delicate with notes of red fruit, strawberries and pepper. Harvested by hand (it grows on slopes too steep for tractors) in spring to maintain its freshness, an excellent wine to while away the hours.</i>	9	28	40
2014 CRFT Pinot Noir, Chapel Valley Vineyard <i>Piccadilly Valley, South Australia</i> <i>Handpicked, unfinned and unfiltered from a small vineyard producing some of the best Pinot Noir grapes in South Australia, this wine is pure in its flavour. Big fruits mix with citrus, spearmint, hints of lavender and pine to produce a truly individual example of Pinot Noir.</i>	11	34	48
2012 Spook Hill 'Temperamental Bloke' Tempranillo <i>Cadel, South Australia</i> <i>Grown on the banks of the Murray, this tempranillo has dark cherry and stone fruit notes with a with a dry liquorice finish.</i>			40
2013 Satyr Syrah <i>Hawke's Bay, New Zealand</i> <i>Dark and deep in colour and full of berries and pepper with a long finish that's not overbearing.</i>			40
