THE WINERY

Harefield Ridge Winery is situated on the Southwest slopes of Australia's Great Dividing Range on the outskirts of Wagga Wagga, the largest inland city in New South Wales. The area covers a diverse and unique terrain with undulating slopes and the alluvial river flats of the Murrumbidgee River. Ideal spring conditions separate cold winters and hot dry summers, providing well suited conditions for the production of premium grapes. Origins in wine 1902.

VINTAGE & WINEMAKING

2013 was an ideal growing season allowing us to really express the colour and rich fruit characters of this wine.

16 months in barrel has intensified body and developed well structured tannins ensuring longevity as the wine ages. A 10% addition of shiraz brings out the fruit characters and results in a superior prize winning wine.

CELLARING & FOODS

Will improve over the next 10 years.
Well suited to being consumed with BBQ short ribs and other red meats.
