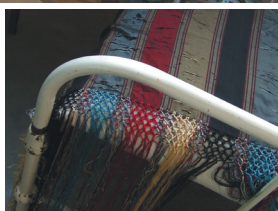
*Local history museum*



The Allansford Cheese World Museum was established in the mid 1990s as a tribute to the western district's hard working farming families.

Situated on the Great Ocean Road in Allansford, opposite the Warrnambool Cheese & Butter Factory, the museum houses an extensive collection of farm implements and household items from everyday life in the early 1900's.

A large proportion of these items were provided to the museum courtesy of the Uebergang family. This collection was established by fifth-generation Allansford farmer Joyce Uebergang as a legacy to her family's years of working the land at Allansford.





Another key display at the museum is the Dave Lee Vintage Engine Collection. Contributed by the Lee family, in conjunction with the Warrnambool and District Historical Vehicle Club (inc), the engines were collected by Dave and his son Doug, who both worked as boring contractors and windmill mechanics in south west Victoria.

A Ruston & Hornsby Engine (1940) takes pride of place amongst a collection of early motoring memorabilia.



Themed exhibits on loan from local collectors change on a regular basis.
