STHUBERT'S

Hubert de Castella established St Hubert's in 1862, by the late 1800's it had grown to be the largest estate in the region with the wines gaining a quick reputation both domestically and abroad. The great depression and the increasing popularity of fortified wine saw grape production cease in 1923. In the 60's the once great site was replanted and so began the rebirth of the Yarra Valley. In 2017 our spiritual home was re-imagined once again and our new contemporary Cellar Door opened its doors in March 2022. Greg Jarratt our current winemaker and custodian, has been making the wines since 2006 and continues what is a long tradition towards craft and excellence.



2015 BLANC DE NOIR

Carefully selected parcels of Yarra Valley fruit. Hand picked, gently whole bunch pressed and fermented in the bottle. The wine has 6 years on lees, prior to disgorging. Creamy and rich, tightly structured palate. Vibrant, crisp and very much in the aperitive style.

2015 SPARKLING ROSÉ

Upper Yarra Pinot Noir, made in the methode traditionnelle, 6 years on lees. Apple pie, nutty nougat, faint red currant and blood orange. A supple mousse with balanced acidity and good drive.

St Hubert's Pinot Noir sourced from valley floor vineyards. Always presents with a rustic charm, more power, tannin, sweeter cherry fruits but still with a fresh acid line.

2021 PINOT BLANC

Single Vineyard (Mornington Peninsula), stainless steel ferment to retain freshness and acidity. Delicate white flowers, savoury lemon curd and a playful acid line, a very European feel.

2019 CHARDONNAY

\$45 bottle St Hubert's Chardonnay, always a wine of power and finesse. The 2019 showing great restrain for a classic Yarra Valley Chardonnay. Nectarine, pear and citrus fruit flavours with flinty notes and classy subtle oak integration.

2016 CABERNET MERLOT

Typically elegant in style but starting to show some amazing secondary characters. Restrained oak, soft but persistant tannins and complex succulent berry fruit notes. A classic "luncheon Claret", a hint of tapenade.



2021 PINOT MEUNIER

Single vineyard from a low lying valley floor site. Vibrant raspberries, cherries, graphite and some serious funk. Truly varietal, plush, round with good spice and a velvety mouthfeel.

2017 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

From a cooler vintage, sourced from our home blocks nestled on the valley floor. A classic Yarra Valley Cabernet. Black pastels and cassis and a hint of cedar and earthy mocha oak. Drink now or cellar for another 5 - 10 years.
